- Troubleshoot & diagnose assigned equipment to make necessary repairs.
- Perform electrical, hydraulic, and mechanical repairs as well as preventative maintenance.
- Determine what parts and tools are necessary to make repairs.
- Report damaged, faulty or unsafe equipment to management.
- Clean equipment for full inspection before returning to work.
- Complete shop paperwork and file daily after executed repairs.
- Maintain a clean and safe work area.
