

Class A CDL Truck Driver Job Description

This requires the ability to safely connect and disconnect trailers and haul materials to and from project sites. This position will require a driver to safely and efficiently back up trucks to specific locations to dump products or feed machinery in a congested construction environment.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Strong knowledge of safety regulations, & DOT operating requirements for operating vehicles over 26,000gvw.
- Possess a clean driving record and valid CDL license.
- Possess a clean driving record with no inattentive, reckless driving, DUI or DWI infractions within the last 10 years.
- Physical fitness, since Truck Drivers are required to pass a physical exam every two years
- Hand-eye coordination, since they must coordinate their hands, legs and eyes to maintain a fast reaction time on the roads
- Visual and hearing acuity, in accordance with federal regulations which mandate that truck drivers have to hear a forced whisper at 5 feet, have at least 20/40 vision, a 70-degree field of vision and the ability to distinguish the colors of traffic lights
- Ability to drive safely, irrespective of traffic, weather, or time of day.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Has through knowledge of operating trucks and trailers with operating weights over 26,000 GVW.
- Complete pre-trip inspection & inspection forms prior to operating vehicle.
- Report any out of compliance items noted prior to operating.
- Ensure the truck always has sufficient fuel and other operating fluids daily.
- Properly secure all loads in accordance with local, State & Federal DOT regulations.
- Track and document transported materials and complete required paperwork daily.
- Obeying and follow all applicable traffic laws.
- Properly secure all loads in accordance with local, State & Federal DOT regulations.
- Maintaining a detailed log of working hours in compliance with state and federal regulations
- Ensuring any mechanical issues with the vehicle are corrected before driving
- Ensure vehicle is never over legal weight or improperly loaded.
- Ensure medical card is always up to date and valid.

Pay & Benefits:
